- Rehearsal for the pageant will be held Friday, March 6, 2020. Rehearsal for Tiny Miss and Little Miss contestants will begin at 6:00 P.M. Rehearsal for Junior Miss, Teen Miss, and Miss will begin at 7:00 P.M. While rehearsal is optional, each contestant is highly encouraged to participate in the rehearsal.
- A **professional photographer will be available** for pictures; a price list will be provided at the rehearsal.
- The <u>judges' score sheets will not be made available to the contestants</u>, so please do not request to see the score sheets or contact the judges after the pageant.
- All pageant contestants are required to participate in a meet-and-greet and interview session with the judges on Saturday, March 7, 2020. This session will be held at Opp High School. Parents may not be in the interview room during the interview process.

Miss Photogenic Information

The photo the contestant submits must be one 5x7 head shot only.

The contestant's name and age group must be on the back of the photo.

The photo must not be in a picture frame.

The photo must be **submitted no later than Friday, March 6, 2020**, and may be submitted at the rehearsal.

Contestants in the <u>Tiny Miss, Little Miss, Junior Miss, and Teen Miss</u> age brackets <u>must submit age-appropriate photos</u>.

If the contestant <u>does not adhere to the above-explained guidelines</u>, the contestant <u>will be disqualified from participating in the Miss Photogenic portion</u> of the pageant.

Pageant Guidelines and Rules

- Any contestant who enters this pageant <u>must</u> be able and willing to <u>participate in any fundraising activities to promote the Opp Rattlesnake Rodeo</u>. Additionally, <u>ALL WINNERS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND AND SUPPORT ALL CHAMBER-and CITY- SPONSORED EVENTS</u> such as Grand Openings, Downtown Get Downs, etc.).
- By participating in the Opp Rattlesnake Rodeo Pageant, the <u>contestants acknowledge</u> <u>they are aware their names</u> (including stage names) <u>and images</u> (including stills, film, digital, video, or other forms of media) <u>will be used for informational, promotional, or broadcasting purposes, etc</u>. This usage may <u>include print, audio, video, on-line, electronic media, or other formats associated with the Opp Rattlesnake Rodeo or any subsequent event.</u>
- The Opp Rattlesnake Rodeo Pageant Committee <u>reserves the right to add or modify</u> <u>rules</u> as deemed necessary. <u>All contestants are required to adhere to pageant rules at all times</u>.
- The Opp Rattlesnake Rodeo Pageant Committee reserves the right to dismiss or disqualify any pageant participant who is found to exhibit any of the following behaviors: being uncooperative, disruptive, tardy, inattentive, defiant, disrespectful, immoral, or non-observant of the pageant rules. This dismissal can occur prior to, during, or in post-pageant activities. If any queen or alternate is deemed to be unfit (see above behaviors), she will be immediately disqualified, and her reign as queen or alternate will be ended. She will then be required to return her crown and sash. Misconduct can and will include inappropriate behaviors identified via social media.

- The <u>first pageant begins at 3:00 P. M</u>, and <u>only one parent or guardian for the age</u> <u>brackets 6 17 is permitted to go backstage with the contestant</u> to assist with preparations. All other family members and/or friends will not be allowed backstage.
- Only <u>pageant participants</u>, the emcee, the <u>pageant's director</u>, the <u>Opp Rattlesnake</u>
 <u>Rodeo Committee members</u>, and <u>designated volunteers will be allowed on the stage</u>
 before, during, or after the pageant.
- Each contestant will be provided with one pass to enter the auditorium for free that can be given to one member of her party. This designated person chosen by the pageant participant must enter at the front entrance and remember to get the required armband. All other family members and/or friends are required to pay the normal fee of \$10.00 to enter the auditorium.
- The winners in each age bracket must be present on Saturday, March 28, 2020, at the Opp Rattlesnake Rodeo.

Rattlesnake Rodeo Event Information

Each <u>queen must arrive to the Opp High School stadium by 11:30 A. M.</u> near the stage and be prepared to be <u>introduced as a member of the Opp Rattlesnake Rodeo Court at 12:00 P. M.</u>

The Miss Queen, 1st Alternate, and 2nd Alternate are required to attend the Rattlesnake Rodeo activities on Saturday to receive their financial awards. This includes participating and assisting with events. You must stay for the remainder of the afternoon and evening.

The <u>Tiny</u>, <u>Little</u>, <u>Junior</u>, <u>and Teen Queens and Alternates</u> are <u>highly encouraged to attend</u> <u>and participate</u> in the <u>Rattlesnake Rodeo activities</u>.
