Food Vendor Rules

- SHOW DATES: March 27, 28, & 2, 2026
- LOCATION OF SHOW: Channell-Lee Football Stadium, 301 Jeffcoat Ave., Opp AL, 36467 Behind Mizell Memorial Hospital.
- NO PETS ALLOWED
- No refunds due to cancellations, rain or any other reason.
- The committee has the right to refuse any vendor misrepresented. Menu/vendors will be limited. Menu selection at the discretion of the committee. **Menu prices must be clearly displayed.** Vendors without visible pricing may be asked to leave the event.
- Spaces are 16 x 12. Space fee is \$300. Electric fee is \$100 for (1) 110 or 220 outlet. City License fee is \$10. Space area includes tongues, racks, tie downs, etc. No sharing or subleasing spaces.
- YOU MUST KEEP YOUR AREA CLEAN, PLEASE BAG TRASH AND PLACE AT BACK OR SIDE OF SITE FOR PICK UP DURING THE SHOW AND AFTER THE EVENT IS OVER.
- All food vendors are required to sell Pepsi products, which must be purchased on-site. Pepsi personnel will be available at the event.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed on site; no obscene items; no fireworks; no firearms.
- City of Opp will not be responsible for loss or theft. Overnight security will be provided.
- After events are over, please take down in an orderly manner, please do not drive on playing surface of the football field.
- Absolutely no disposal of grease or oil is permitted anywhere on site. Any violation will result in a \$500.00 fine.
- ALL VENDORS SETUP will be Thursday, March 26, 2026 from 10am until 7pm. FOR RESTOCKING you may drive in early am and must be out by 7:30am. Set up time is very congested. Please unload and remove trailers and vehicles as quickly as possible. This allows for others to set up as well. All Vendors must be set up by Friday, March 27, at 4:00pm.
- No vehicles will be allowed in the stadium until after events are over. Any vehicle in the stadium during event will be fined.
- Exhibitors are responsible for manning their booths; four people will be given free entry with each booth. Additional help will need to purchase vendor pass for \$10 each. Exhibitors will be provided with two (2) parking passes. Every vendor will be required to have their armband on before entering the event.
- Each vendor is responsible for following all Alabama Health Department rules and regulations as well as fire safety codes. Must have fire extinguishers to code (See Fire Marshal Concession Guidelines). Inspection will be late Friday and early Saturday.
- Each vendor must meet the National Electrical Code Standard.
- Gates open at 5:00 PM on Friday, 9:00 AM on Saturday, and 10:00 AM on Sunday. The event will continue each day until the final performance concludes.
- Deadline for applications is Monday, March 9, 2026. Keep in mind the spaces fill quickly.

If you have to cancel before the event, refunds will be considered but not guaranteed if you notify us by Monday, March 16, 2026.

Reminder: No additional spaces will be available on the day of the event. Please ensure you reserve the correct number of spaces needed for your display. Each space measures 16 feet by 12 feet. When planning, account for the full size of your tent, trailer, and any other equipment. All parts of your setup must fit entirely within the allotted 16' x 12' space. This includes tongue.

Set-up times and additional event details

If, for any reason, you need to cancel after being approved, please contact us as soon as possible.

We would rather have the opportunity to fill your space and refund your payment.

However, vendors who do not show up without notice will not receive a refund and will be added to our "No Return List" for future events.

Food Vendor Information:

Food vendor applications are only for vendors who will be cooking at the event or preparing drinks on site.

If you sell prepackaged food items such as cookies, candies, jams, jerky, or similar goods, you will fall under the Arts & Crafts category and should complete that application instead.
