- · LOCATION OF SHOW: Channell-Lee Football Stadium, 301 Jeffcoat Ave. Opp, Al 36467.
- · NO PETS ALLOWED.
- · No refunds due to cancellations, rain, or any other reason; the committee has the right to refuse any exhibit misrepresented. Similar items may be limited.
- · Items must be new, exhibitor is responsible for furnishing own tables, tents, racks, extension cords, etc. Spaces are 12x12; this includes tie downs, trailer tongues, etc. Space fee: \$100, Electric fee: \$50 for (1) outlet; City License fee: \$10. No sharing or subleasing spaces.
- · City of Opp will not be responsible for loss or theft, overnight security will be provided.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed on site; no fireworks; no firearms; no obscene items allowed; no laser pointers allowed; no fart poppers; no invisible ink balls.
- After events are over, please take down in orderly manner; please do not drive on playing surface of football field.
- ALL VENDORS, set up will begin Thursday March 26, 2026 from 10am until 7pm. No vehicles or trailers will be allowed in stadium until after the events are over. Set up is very congested, please unload and remove trailers and vehicles. All vendors must be set up by Friday, March 27, at 4:00pm.
- Exhibitors are responsible for setting up and manning their booth, two people will be given free entry with each booth. Additional helpers will need to purchase vendor pass for \$10 each.
- · If you do not have a vendor armband on, you will not be allowed into the event.
- · Each vendor must meet the National Electrical Code Standard.
- · Deadline for applications is Monday, March 9, 2026. Keep in mind the spaces fill quickly.
- Gates open at 5:00 PM on Friday, 9:00 AM on Saturday, and 10:00 AM on Sunday. The event will continue each day until the final performance concludes.
- No vehicles will be allowed in the stadium until after events are over. Any vehicle in the stadium during event will be fined.
